Transportation from Budapest Airport to Szeged

Also addressing the issue of early morning transportation

Coming from the airport, Terminal 2, you would need to go to Terminal 1 (taking bus 200, the only public service) and buy the train ticket in the waiting lounge (no vending machine on the platform, conductors sell tickets only for a penalty on the train).

There is NO need to get from the airport to Nyugati Station in the city centre. The trains leave from Ferihegy 1 at 10 minutes past the hour (the stop is not indicated in the timetable on the website). If you check the website you'll see that there is a train every hour from 6 am to 8pm. You also need to buy a reservation ticket.

Anyone who has an early morning flight on their return will need to book a shuttle bus from the travel agent called MORTON'S in Szeged on Petőfi sugárút 7, (close to the venue of the conference). <http://www.mortons.hu> Tel: 36 62 420-088. It leaves at 2:45 from outside the TESCO's shop on the Rókusi krt and arrives in two hours at the BUD airport. To get to the terminal of the shuttle bus you simply take a taxi. The shuttle service one way is some 5000 HUF (much cheaper than renting a car or taking a taxi).

Transportation from Budapest to Szeged

If you spend a few days in Budapest before going to Szeged, your best option is the Intercity train from the Nyugati train station.
