The Balaton is Cleveland’s oldest Hungarian restaurant still in operation. It was formerly located in the old Cleveland ethnic Hungarian neighborhood of Buckeye Road, but has since relocated to a nice spot on Shaker Square. TOP RATINGS have been awarded by both reader choice polls as well as many accredited food writers for publications including: *Cleveland Magazine, Northern Ohio Live Magazine, Ohio Magazine, The Cleveland Plain Dealer, Scene, Free Times, Connections, Shaker Magazine* and more. . . . .

#### **AHEA BANQUET MENU:**

- Cup of authentic Hungarian goulash – *valódi gulyás leves*
- Bread (from a Hungarian bakery) & butter – *vajas kenyér*
- Choice of garden salad or Hungarian style cucumber salad – *sima saláta vagy uborka saláta*
- Entrée served family style – any or all of the following: chicken paprikás, veal paprikás, stuffed cabbage, wiener schnitzel; with side of spaetzle – *csirke paprikás, borjú paprikás, töltött káposzta, bécsi szelet; nokedlivel*
- Dessert: Hungarian style “Napoleon” (flaky pastry, vanilla custard, whipped cream, from the popular Farkas Hungarian Pastry shop in Cleveland) – *krémes rétes*
- Coffee, tea, soft drinks – *kávé, tea, üdítő*
- CASH BAR on premises: Large selection of Hungarian wines by the bottle or glass, beer, selected liqueurs – *Magyar borok, sör, válogatott likörök*

**Vegetarian** – The restaurant has offered to work out a meatless menu for vegetarians on-site; it will equal the cost of the banquet menu. Please indicate if you wish “vegetarian” on the registration form.

**IMPORTANT REQUEST:** Conference participants – **please do NOT make your AHEA banquet reservation directly with the Balaton restaurant** – everyone is asked to go through AHEA and the pre-registration process for the Saturday banquet. ### **On-Campus OPTION # 1:**

**OUR RECOMMENDED OPTION: The JCU student cafeteria.**

**Pre-registration and pre-payment required. See the Conference registration form. You will receive a meal ticket for each meal in your registration packet, after you arrive on campus.**

All Friday and Saturday AHEA events will occur in the Lombardo Student Center, the same building as the student cafeteria (Schott Dining Hall), so lunch and/or dinner here on Friday and lunch on Saturday would be very convenient for you. Both the student cafeteria (See Registration form for meal tickets.) as well as the deli snack bar are in the basement of this building.

The cafeteria has a student atmosphere but there are quieter corners too. The food is good quality. It is served buffet style, all-you-can-eat, and no limit on beverages. Choices include hot plated daily specials (meat/fish, potatoes/rice/other side dish, hot veggies), hot and cold sandwiches (hamburgers, hot dogs, veggie burgers, fries, cold cuts & cheeses), soups, and Italian table (pizza, spaghetti, calzone), an extended salad bar, fresh fruit, and many other items. 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## **On-Campus OPTION # 2: On-Campus food at “THE INN BETWEEN” or at “EINSTEIN BROTHERS BAGELS”**

### **THE INN BETWEEN**

For lighter appetites, the INN-BETWEEN is a deli style café (burgers, fries, hot and cold sandwiches, flatbread pizza, salads, beverages), pay à la carte, no pre-registration necessary. It is also located in Lombardo Student Center basement and right in front of the student cafeteria. You order your food at a counter and sit at booths to eat it. Prices are about \$ 2 - \$8. Hours of operation are: Monday-Friday: 11:00 am – 1:00 am, Saturday-Sunday: 3:00 pm – 1:00 am. Here is the website for more information:

### **EINSTEIN BROTHERS BAGELS**

This is another deli style café, pay à la carte, no pre-registration necessary, located in the basement of the Administration building (the one with the big clock tower in the middle of campus). Brunch type items, soups, hot and cold sandwiches served mostly on bagels. Prices are
