Fodor's Review:

This relatively inexpensive hotel can be found in rather noble quarters—one wing of a magnificent 1902 neo-baroque castle in the heart of the luxurious Castle District. The building's main tenants are a cultural foundation and a large wine center, so part of the charm is navigating your way through the cavernous entry hall, up the sweeping staircase, and down the hallway to finally reach the hotel's small reception desk. Rooms come with two or three beds and are very basic but peaceful; they have showers but no tubs. Children under 14 can share their parents' room for free. The neighborhood is simply magical, even if it is often overrun with tourists. Reserve well in advance.
